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Furthermore, your choice of Executor (the person who will be carrying out the directions in your Will) may have changed. As well, if you have wishes regarding healthcare that you want communicated to a physician/hospital if you become unable to "speak for yourself" consider a Personal Directive. Finally, an Enduring Power of Attorney may be appropriate. This document permits your prescribed attorney to take care of your finances, if you become unable to do so.

Expect the Best but Plan for the Unexpected

Time to get your personal affairs in order. Do you have a Will? This is very important if you want to be the person to decide the distribution of your estate. In any event, separation and divorce may cause you to change your wishes regarding who gets what.
